#### A. List of requested project reappropriations and withdrawal.

The CCC requests the reappropriation of the following projects:

- 0002488 Sequoias Community College District, College of the Sequoias: Basic Skills Center Construction
- 0006503 Sierra Joint Community College District, Sierra College: Gymnasium Modernization Working Drawings
- 0006504 Barstow Community College District, Barstow College: Hydronic Loop and Water Infrastructure Working Drawings
- 0006570 Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Chabot College: Building 3000 Maintenance Operations Warehouse & Garage Working Drawings

#### B. Project Detail:

0002488 Sequoias Community College District, College of the Sequoias: Basic Skills Center - Construction

COBCP Abstract: \$13,876,000 for the state share of construction. The total project costs are estimated at \$16,913,000 including preliminary plans (\$838,000), working drawings (\$527,000) and construction (\$15,548,000). The preliminary plans were completed in June 2020. The working drawings began in June 2020 and were to be completed in May 2021. Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2021 and be completed in April 2023.

Purpose of Reappropriation: This project experienced several months of delay due to extended Division of the State Architect (DSA) review, back checks, and revisions to ensure structural integrity of the building and to address fire/life safety and Americans with Disabilities Act compliance factors. DSA approved the working drawings in May 2021, but it is possible that the CCC will not receive approval to proceed to bid for this project in the current year and, therefore, a reappropriation is needed to ensure continuity of project authority should there be additional delay.

<u>0006503 Sierra Joint Community College District, Sierra College: Gymnasium Modernization - Working Drawings</u>

COBCP Abstract: \$1,141,000 for the state share of working drawings. The total project costs are estimated at \$36,637,000 including preliminary plans (\$1,691,000), working drawings (\$1,521,000) and construction (\$33,425,000). The preliminary plans were completed in May 2021. The working drawings are expected to begin in June 2021 and be completed in July 2022. Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2022 and be completed in November 2024.

Purpose of Reappropriation: The preliminary plans for this project were extended to obtain approval to add an approximately 4,000 gross square foot covered walkway adjacent to the gymnasium lobby. Preliminary plans were completed in May 2021, but it is possible that the CCC will not receive approval to proceed with working drawings in the current year and, therefore, a reappropriation is needed to ensure continuity of project authority should there be additional delay.

0006504 Barstow Community College District, Barstow College: Hydronic Loop and Water Infrastructure - Working Drawings

COBCP Abstract: \$282,000 for the state share of working drawings. The total project costs are estimated at \$9,920,000 including preliminary plans (\$459,000), working drawings (\$282,000) and construction (\$9,179,000). The preliminary plans will completed in June 2021. The working drawings are estimated to begin in June 2021 and be completed in June 2022. Construction is scheduled to begin in November 2022 and be completed in April 2024.

Purpose of Reappropriation: The preliminary plans for this project were extended to ensure appropriate ventilation for the hydronic loop, as the loop is the source of heating and cooling campus-wide. Preliminary plans should be completed in June 2021, but it is possible that the CCC will not receive approval to proceed with working drawings in the current year and, therefore, a reappropriation is needed to ensure continuity of project authority should there be additional delay.

0006570 Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Chabot College: Building 3000 Maintenance Operations Warehouse & Garage - Working Drawings

COBCP Abstract: \$249,000 for the state share of working drawings. The total project costs are estimated at \$17,529,000 including preliminary plans (\$850,000), working drawings (\$498,000) and construction (\$16,181,000). The preliminary plans should be completed in June 2021. The working drawings should begin in June 2021 and be completed in April 2022. Construction is scheduled to begin in July 2022 and be completed in July 2024.

Purpose of Reappropriation: This district is completing value engineering tasks to bring the project within the approved cost and scope. Preliminary plans should be completed in June 2021, but it is possible that the CCC will not receive approval to proceed with working drawings in the current year and, therefore, a reappropriation is needed to ensure continuity of project authority should there be additional delay.
